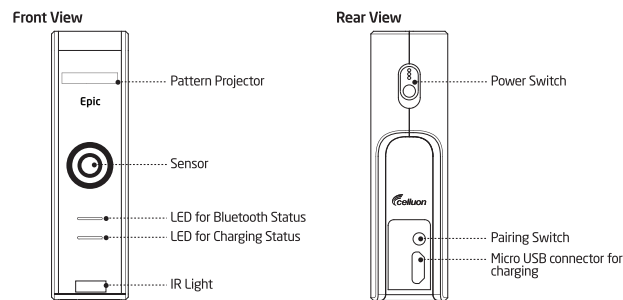


Epic Quick Guide



Connecting Epic

Epic connects via Bluetooth (does not connect via USB)
Compatible operating systems:
- iOS 4.0 and later (most iPhone and iPad)
- Android 4.0 and later
- Windows XP and later (not compatible with Windows Phone 7 and Phone 8)
- Mac OS X 1.0 and later
- Blackberry 10

Note: Epic is compatible with any Bluetooth HID supporting devices.
USB connection is solely used for charging the battery.

1. Turn on Epic.
2. Turn on Bluetooth through Bluetooth settings; search for nearby devices.
3. When device discovers "Celluon PK series," tap to connect.
4. Solid blue LED indicates successful pairing.

Enabling Pairing Mode

1. Turn on Epic.
2. Locate pairing switch (refer to above illustration).
3. Press and hold pairing switch for about 2 seconds. A beep sound will indicate pairing mode.
4. Pair with device (refer to "Connecting Epic" steps 1-4).

*Epic will automatically connect with previously paired device when powered on.

NOTE: Epic works on any flat, opaque surface. When Epic is placed on uneven surfaces, it may not work properly.

**When using Epic on slanted surfaces such as an airplane tray table, please note that device and/or projected keyboard layout may shift.

How to Adjust Settings

Volume +	FN + Up arrow (↑)	Volume -	FN + Down arrow (↓)
Brightness +	FN + Right arrow (→)	Brightness -	FN + Left arrow (←)
Sensitivity +	FN + >.	Sensitivity -	FN + <.

Power Saving Mode: Tap and hold "FN" and tap "BACK" to disable laser projection. To turn on laser projection, quickly tap operational area with 3 fingers (keep fingers separated).

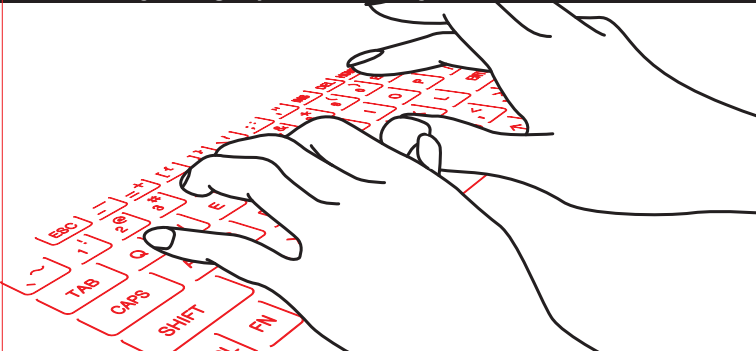
Charging the Battery

Please use provided Micro USB cable to charge Epic through any USB port or adapter.
When battery depletes to low level, lower LED flashes in Red for 5 minutes before shutting off.
When Epic is extremely low on power, it needs to charge for up to 5 minutes before you can use it.

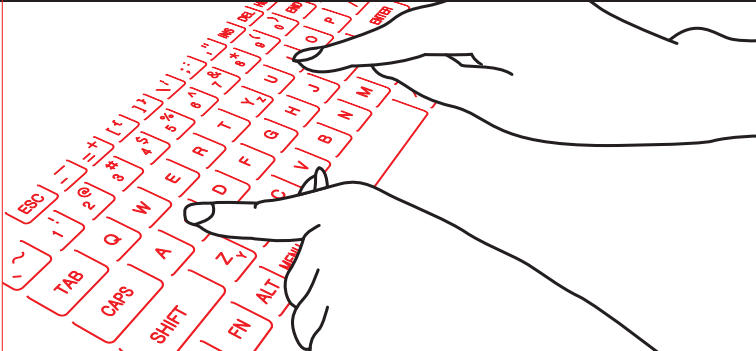
How to Type Properly on Epic

Epic is designed for mobile devices, including smartphone and tablet PC.
Using mobile projection keyboard is slightly different than typing on a traditional keyboard.
Use same approach as you would on a touch screen keyboard.
Learning curve is short and easy, and most users adapt quickly in just few tries.

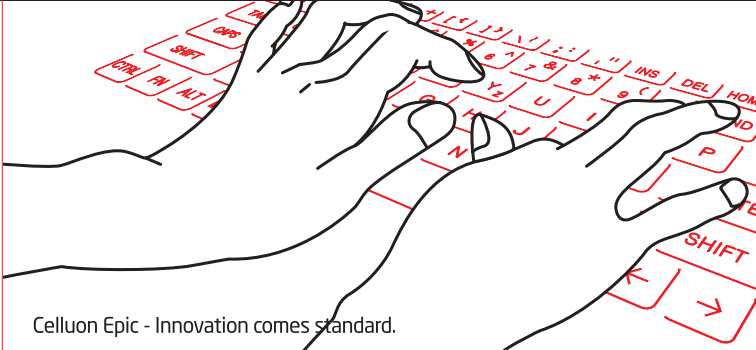
1. ELEVATE your fingers just above the keys



2. LOOK at the keys as you start typing in hunt-and-peck style



3. ADD MORE FINGERS as you become comfortable with the new approach
